**Aye and Oat's mother died in June - 2 more children has lost a mother.**

In February Inger Lise visited Dim who was hospitalized in Mae Hong Son.

Dim had a hard time because she had no more her AIDS medicine. Dim was hospitalized, but she was doing better when Inger Lise visited her.

The visit gave Inger Lise a great joy. Dim talked much about heaven and about her faith in Jesus. She was just shining of joy thinking about heaven.

A couple of months later Dim went to heaven. She died, trusting her saviour Jesus Christ.

AIDS Care helped arrange the funeral and paid most of the expenses.
